That Jesus' crucified body was resurrected from the dead (Luke 24:6-7, Acts 2:23-24, Acts 3:14-15, Acts 10:39-41, Acts 13:29-30, Rom 1:4).

That Jesus ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19, Luke 24:51, Acts 1:9, Heb 4:14, I Peter 3:22).

That Jesus will personally return with power and great glory (Matt 24:29-30, Matt 26:64, Luke 21:27, Acts 1:11, Heb 9:28).

All mankind inherits a depraved nature and consists of lost sinners in need of salvation (Rom 3:9-19, Rom 3:23, Eph 2:1-3).

God has provided salvation through offering His Son on the cross of Calvary and allowing Jesus' blood to be shed as an atonement for the sins of all who believe (Matt 26:28, Rom 3:20-25, Rom 5:10-12, Eph 1:7, Col 1:14, 1 John 1:7, Rev 1:5).

That lost and sinful man is saved and justified when he admits himself to be a sinner and puts his trust in Jesus Christ as the Son of God and in His finished work on the cross of Calvary. This trust is accompanied by repentance from sin and regeneration of the Holy Spirit (Luke 13:3, 5, Rom 3:24, Rom 4:4-8, Eph 2:8-10, Titus 2:11-14, Titus 3:5-7, 2 Cor 5:17, Acts 2:38).

That saved man is set free from the power of sin by the grace of God (John 8:34-36, Rom 6:6-7, 11-14, Rom 8:2-4).

In the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a holy and Godly life (Jer 31:31-34, Ezek 36:27, 1 John 2:27, Acts 1:8, 1 John 5:6, Neh 9:20, Luke 12:12, John 14:26, 1 Cor 2:13, John 16:13).

In the resurrection of both the saved and the lost—they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (Dan 12:1-2, Acts 24:15).

In the spiritual unity of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ (Eph 4:3-4, 13, Phil 2:1-2, 1 Cor 12:13).
